What is Women TechEU?

A 2-year EU-funded project supporting women leading **deep tech startup companies** from Europe and Associated Countries.

Our mission is to create a more **gender-balanced** entrepreneurship ecosystem. Diversity drives innovation, and we are here to provide women in deep tech with more opportunities, resources, and support to thrive.

The project will launch **4 calls** for applications over the span of 2 years which, following a rigorous evaluation process, will result in a total of **160 beneficiaries**.





Women-Led Company:

- A woman is legally recognised as co/founder of the company and must currently hold a top management position (CEO, CTO, CSO or equivalent)
- Women need to make up **together 25%** of the company in **total**, but the woman co/founder does not need to hold all 25% herself.
- It has to be a private company any other type of legal entity is NOT accepted.





Women-Led Company:

We can only count the full **CAP** table. The 100% will be including institutions, banks, other shareholders, business angels etc.

The CAP table will ask you for gender (if applicable) of all shareholders listed.




BETWEEN 6 MONTHS - 8 YEARS FROM SUBMISSION

BEFORE REACHING HIGH FIDELITY MINIMUM VIABLE PRODUCT (TRL3-6) RAISED **LIMITED FUNDING** (UP TO 1 MILLION EUR IN EQUITY AT SUBMISSION)











Raised less than 1M€ in equity:


- Keeping focus on **emerging Startups**
- Grants and other national non-dilutive subsidies are **excluded** as long as not previous Women TechEU grants, EIC Accelerator or similar cascade funds like Empowomen
- IM€ in equity to be strictly against purchased shares by external parties
- **Convertible loans** are considered **equity** if money is available
- The participation of public bodies as shareholders is considered for the equity pool if they are in the CAP table
- Cash from Business Angels/VC count to the 1M in equity
- Variations of **sweat-equity are NOT counted** towards the limit





Raised less than 1M€ in equity:

Be mindful of the question! The ELIGIBLE answer to this question in the application is "YES".









What is deep tech?

Building technology that doesn't exist... **YET!** This is **technology on the edge of science**. It's about pioneering extremely innovative products/services that have never been seen before to solve societal problems.

Not bound by sector but some sectors we tend to see deep tech work in include:

- Life sciences
- Greentech
- Biotechnology
- And more..





Refining the deep tech eligibility criteria:



The deep tech company



MUST be leveraging breakthroughs in scientific fields







MUST have its core technology based on recent scientific advancements or pushing boundaries in established fields

MUST have technology with the potential to disrupt the existing markets or create entirely new ones

MUST have a solution that is genuinely innovative and not just an incremental improvement

Can ideally have its technology scaled efficiently and reach a broad audience

*The deep tech MUST be yours and not "borrowed"











My company uses technology in the delivery of its goods / services, am I eligible to apply?

Using technology and being a deep tech company are **very different concepts.** Just because one is adopting industry standard technologies or slightly modifying content, materials, integration of existing components etc, does not make the company a deep tech one! **NOT deep tech**:

- eLearning platforms where the content is the innovative part and **not** the technology;
- eCommerce apps where the innovation is the business model/pricing, **not** the technology
- Gaming apps which use **industry standard components**
- Online information portals where **the news and articles** are the innovative component





We use/want to use AI applications in our company, that means we are deep tech, right?

Not necessarily! You need to identify the stage you are in:

Concept development

Dataset collection

Algorithm development



AI model development Training of AI model with dataset Testing / piloting of trained AI model Refinement of AI model post testing/ piloting

Third countries associated to Horizon Europe

Association to Horizon Europe is governed by the Horizon Europe Regulation 2021/05¹². Legal entities from the EU Member States, unless specific limitations or conditions as legal entities from the EU Member States, unless specific limitations or conditions are alid down in the work programme and/or califycip text. Such measures could include the limitation of participation in certain actions to legal entities established in the EU strategic assets, interests, autonomy or security. Limitations or conditions may also be strated to the participation regal entities established in an eligible country but which are controlled directly or indirectly by an ineligible country. The eligibility will be clearly establishment of the legal entity to take inthe account specific policy requirements or the nature and objectives of the action².

All sixteen non-EU countries associated to the previous programme, Horizon 2020, have also expressed interest to become associated to Horizon Europe. Other third countries have also expressed an interest in association.

Eligible countries:

- Not just the EU!
- The applicable list is the one published by the European Commission at the time of opening of call, <u>linked in the FAQs and Call Guidelines</u>
- For ease of reference, we have listed the eligible non-EU countries **in our FAQs**.





Age of Company:

- The age of the company is determined by **the date of its registration** in the national company register of the country it is registered in.
- This date needs to be **greater than 6 months and less than 8 years** at the date of the submission of the application
- Even if there was a **period of inactivity**, this time is still counted in the age of the company





What can be funded by the EUR 75,000 grant?

It is up to you!

Choose how you plan to allocate funds towards activities that will accelerate the development, growth and sustainability of **your** business.

Independent experts will assess whether the proposed activities are most appropriate and required to support your company's growth and development .







Documents and attachments required at application stage:







Documents required **IF** selected for funding (1)

- **ID Number & scanned copy** of the signatory (irrelevant personal details may be covered)
- The **power of attorney** of the person who will sign the Sub-grantee agreement
- SME declaration form
- Balance Sheet and P&L accounts for the last 2 closed years
- Most recent CAP table
- Financial Identification Form identifying account funds will be transferred to
- **Bank statement** showing ownership of account





Documents required IF selected for funding (2)

For entities that are already **validated** by the European Commission's Funding and Tenders Portal:

- PIC Number
- Screenshot of their type of organisation from the F&T portal

If not validated:

- Legal entity form
- VAT Number registration (if applicable)







Failing to provide requested data and documents in due time will mean the funding will not be awarded!






Hints and Tips for a great application

- **Be authentic.** When creating the video, we are not after professional style but we want to hear your voice and your passion
- Why you? Tell us how you are advancing your area of science, how you are helping society and why we should give you this opportunity
- Show commitment. To the cause you believe in, to your company and to advancing women's role in deep tech
- **Don't use AI.** We know what ChatGPT sounds like, we want to hear YOUR voice and not what an algorithm thinks you should say





Common mistakes in previous call: **PROCRASTINATION!**







Common mistakes in previous call: **PROCRASTINATION!**

The deadline is the deadline. No exceptions will be made for **ANY** circumstance.

Plan your submission ahead of time (**minimum recommended 2 days**) due to technical or personal issues that may crop up.

Reporting technical issues to the Helpdesk after the deadline will not be accepted.





Common mistakes in previous call: **Eligibility!**

- One common **mistake** was selecting the **incorrect eligibility criteria**. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure **accuracy**, and unfortunately, we cannot rectify such errors.
- Moreover if the applicant starts the application and they see that from the initial questions they **do not meet the eligibility criteria**, they should refrain from **continuing with their submission**, as this will result anyhow in <u>disqualification</u>.





Common mistakes in previous call: Trying to amend information PAST DEADLINE

No information or additional documentation will be accepted or considered by evaluators that was submitted to the Sploro platform or to the Helpdesk past the deadline.

If you made a mistake, this cannot under any circumstances be amended.







Common mistakes in previous call:



The video:

- **NOT** showing the woman co/founder and the company's personal story.
- Providing a corporate video instead of a recorded self-presentation.
- Past the **3 minute** cut-off.
- Uploaded onto incorrect platforms (see FAQs/Guidelines).





Common mistakes in previous call: Language!





ENGLISH IS OUR WORKING LANGUAGE All application, documents, deck, video **must be in English.** Video in another language and English subtitles NOT accepted.

OFFICIAL DOCUMENTS IN YOUR LANGUAGE:

Permissible, but provide a translation.

- Helpdesk should be your final point of contact, not your initial one. Please read the Guidelines and FAQs thoroughly before contacting the Helpdesk.
- We regularly update our FAQs and have installed a search bar to facilitate information finding.











Evaluation & Appeal



- From this next call, the appeal process will be streamlined via an online submission form on the Women TechEU website, which will be **available ONLY for the eligible 7** day period post-results.
- Different opinions do not mean that you can appeal. The experts have been engaged to give us **their opinion** based on their extensive experience.
- Only if there are **factual errors in their evaluation** that you can send a proof of in the evaluation, then you can appeal (e.g. they refer to your company by a different name that is not yours)
